

Universal Studios

Your child has been invited to attend a trip to Universal Studios, with the Club Live Group from Goleta Valley Junior High. The event will take place on Saturday, February 9th, 2008. The students will be transported by a bus that will leave from GVJH. We will meet **at 7:45am in front of GVJH** and **the students will be dropped off again at the same location at 8pm**. If it looks like we are going to arrive home earlier students will arrange to call parents or guardians on the way home. The tickets will cost \$37 each. The cost of transportation will be \$10 each. **The students will give Marla, the Club Live advisor, \$47 for the trip by Tuesday, February 5th.** Students will need to keep track of their own extra money brought for lunch/dinner. We have estimated that students will need about \$15 for food. *Although, for your information, there are 3 restaurants that have kid's meals that will save some money: Hollywood Grill, Mel's Dinner and Doc Brown (The name Doc Brown might change by the time we are there).* Each kid's meal is only \$6. If there is anyone who is having a financial hardship please contact Marla at GVJH(967-3486 x. 206). There will be adult chaperones for the bus ride to and from Universal Studios but once we get to the park students will be able to roam around the park by themselves. There will be a check in spot at the park and a phone number that they can call in case of an emergency.

What to Bring:

- ~ Extra money for dinner (or students can wait until we get home).
- ~ Jacket - (can be tied around waist or they can rent a locker).
- ~ students should be dressed according to school dress code (baseball hat or visor okay in park only – still needs to adhere to dress codes as far as logos)
- ~ water: only if it is in a sealed bottle. They also allow fruit to be brought into the park (natural, not packaged - as far as I understand).

What not to Bring/Wear:

- ~If drugs and/or alcohol are brought on the bus or in the park the student's parents will be called and parents will need to drive to the park to pick their student up. The student is also subject to school policy discipline since this is a school event.
- ~ For this Club Live Event the students are not allowed to bring food into the park.
- ~Other personal items will be brought at their own risk (example: cell phones, cameras, electronic music equipment, etc.)
